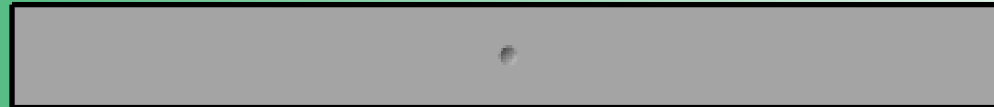


Let's make the rule together!

THE NEGATIVE

To make the negative form, we simply put NOT after the verb to be.

Ex: The boys **are** NOT listening to music.

Sarah is NOT doing her homework.

*You can also use make the contraction. Ex. The boys **AREN'T** listening....

Sarah ISN'T doing her homework.
